In the past year, contributions to our Disaster Relief Fund have been used to provide the following assistance:

- \$50,000 for Hurricane Laura Relief in the Diocese of Lake Charles, Louisiana
- \$50,000 for Hurricane Laura Relief in the Diocese of Beaumont, Texas
- \$100,000 for COVID-19 Relief in the Diocese of St. Petersburg
- \$250,000 for Hurricane Dorian Relief in the Archdiocese of Nassau, Bahamas
